2009 Hong Kong Scholarship Application

Our 2009 Hong Kong Scholarship is accepting application now until the deadline of 1/16/2009. This year, HKSAF Scholarship Foundation will accept students with 7As in HKCEE or equivalent such as the IGCSE exam. Hong Kong will change its education system from 3-4-3 (3 years of junior high, 4 years of senior high, 3 years of university) to 3-3-4 in 2012, and the last cohort sitting for HKCEE will be in 2010. In light of this change, our scholarship foundation will work with educators in Hong Kong to modify our scholarship requirement. We welcome information and suggestions from our members and friends on this issue.
